The performance of first-time real estate license examination candidates by approved school and instructor is monitored by the North Carolina Real Estate Commission and regularly reported to schools and instructors. School and instructor examination performance records are reviewed annually by the North Carolina Real Estate Commission to help assure that quality instruction is being provided in prelicensing courses by such schools and instructors.

During the July 1, 2014 - June 30, 2015 annual reporting period, you achieved a real estate license examination performance record of **80% or higher** on the grading scale. Of the 106 instructors with students who took the license exam for the first time during this reporting period, you were **one of only 20 instructors** to reach this level of performance. The overall performance for all first-time examination candidates was 60%. Your performance report for this annual reporting period was e-mailed to you on July 17, 2015.

The North Carolina Real Estate Commission wants to congratulate you for this achievement. We recognize to have your students perform at such a level on the license examination requires a combination of high quality instruction and high course completion standards.
