Dear School Director:

The performance of first-time real estate license examination candidates by approved school and instructor is monitored by the North Carolina Real Estate Commission and regularly reported to schools and instructors. School and instructor examination performance records are reviewed annually by the North Carolina Real Estate Commission to help assure that quality instruction is being provided in prelicensing courses by such schools and instructors.

During the July 1, 2014 - June 30, 2015 annual reporting period, your school compiled a real estate license examination performance record **between 70 - 79%** on the grading scale. Of the 72 schools with students who took the license exam for the first time during this reporting period, your school was **one of 10 schools** to reach this level of performance. The overall performance for all first-time examination candidates was 60%. Your school's performance report for this annual reporting period was e-mailed to you on July 17, 2015.

The North Carolina Real Estate Commission wants to congratulate your school for this achievement. We recognize to have your students perform at such a level on the license examination requires a combination of high quality instruction and high course completion standards.
